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INTRODUCTION

This Annual Report of the Arkansas State Board of Nursing is prepared and distributed in accordance with the *Nurse Practice Act of the State of Arkansas*, Arkansas Code Annotated, Section 17-87-203(4).

It contains information regarding the Board's activities, as well as information about nurses licensed by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing, organized by licensure type and county of residence. Data on the supply and distribution of nurses licensed and residing in Arkansas is included in Appendix B of this report. This data is obtained from responses during license renewal.

MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of the Arkansas State Board of Nursing is to protect the public and act as their advocate by effectively regulating the practice of nursing.

GOAL STATEMENTS

We, the Arkansas State Board of Nursing, will:

BOARD FUNCTIONS


The Arkansas State Board of Nursing has a legislative mandate to protect the public by assuring that any person practicing nursing is qualified to do so. The current law governing the Board of Nursing is covered under the *Nurse Practice Act of the State of Arkansas* (reprinted from Arkansas Code Annotated §17-87-101 - §17-87-711.)

In keeping with the power and responsibilities in the *Nurse Practice Act*, the Board:

- Maintains an office for the administration of its business and employs personnel necessary for carrying out its functions;
- Examines, licenses and renews licenses of duly qualified applicants for nursing licensure;
- Examines, certifies and renews certifications of duly qualified applicants for medication assistants;
- Prescribes minimum standards, approves curricula, surveys and approves educational programs preparing persons for nursing licensure and medication assistant certification;
- Promulgates rules necessary for the implementation of the Act and submits these to the Arkansas legislative bodies for review;
- Develops and recommends role levels of technical classes of nursing serve and practice to state and federal health agencies and to public and private administrative bodies;
- Conducts disciplinary proceedings and causes prosecution of persons violating the Act; and
- Grants certificates of prescriptive authority to qualified advanced practice nurses.

BOARD OF NURSING MEMBERS AND STAFF

BOARD ACTIVITIES

In the past year the Arkansas State Board of Nursing met three days for business sessions and twelve days for disciplinary hearings. Board members and staff participated in Nursing Education advisory group meetings, regional and national meetings of the National Council of State Boards of Nursing; consulted with nursing education programs, health care agencies, other governmental agencies; and met with professional nursing organizations.

The Board complies with the Arkansas Freedom of Information Act and informs the news media of dates and times of all meetings. All Board deliberations and meetings are open to the public except matters that involve personnel or test information covered by security agreements. Accomplishments of note for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008 include the following:

- Conducted continuing education workshops entitled “Nursing Regulation and Practice” at various locations around the state
- Conducted the sixth annual orientation for Nurse Educators
- Coordinated the third annual continuing education cruise for nurses from fourteen states
- Contracted with testing vendor and began certification exam for medication assistants
- Revised School Nurse Guidelines
- Co-sponsored the fifth annual Nursing Expo with employees and educators to address the nursing shortage
- In coordination with the nurses association, developed an online professional behaviors course
- Working with nurses association to develop a Scope of Practice educational program for LPNs to be used for LPN Equivalency applicants
- Accepted AACN Adult CNS Certification for Prescriptive Authority
- Developed guidelines for and began issuing letter of reprimand for first time positive urine drug screen on pre-employment UDS
- Began processing criminal background checks online
- Prepared and presented to board members “Signs of Financial Difficulty” form so as to be educated regarding things to look for and ask about concerning financial matters
- Approved Position Statement 08-1 – Expedited Partner Therapy
- Approved the position that the use of protocols without a licensed provider initiation is not within the RN Scope of Practice
- Began sending cards and increased online renewals to 90 percent
- Continued involvement with the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) with four staff members serving on national committees. Executive Director Faith Fields serves as President of the Board of Directors. Dr. Calvina Thomas serves on the Item Review Subcommittee for the licensure examination. Sue Tedford serves as chair of the Continued Competency Committee. Board member Lepaine McHenry serves on the Practice, Regulation and Education Committee.

BUDGET

The Arkansas State Board of Nursing does not receive appropriations of general revenue from the state. Nurse licensure fees constitute the agency's primary financial support. The fiscal year 2008 total revenue was \$2,362,808.79. Expenses for the FY totaled \$2,169,067.57. Total revenue and expenses includes Board of Nursing operating fund, nursing student loan fund, continuing education workshop fund, and criminal background check fund.

The Board is required to pay 1.7% or 3.4% of revenue fees depending upon the type collected to the Treasury of the State of Arkansas. These funds are credited to the State's General Fund for appropriation to various other agencies and services of state government. The Board paid \$33,786.40 to the General Fund for FY 2008. The financial statement and graphs on the following pages reflect the breakdown of revenue and expenses for the fiscal year 2008.

The Nursing Student Loan fund is a separate fund used only for the purpose of providing loans/scholarships to nursing students. The program is funded by donations that are deposited into the designated fund. From these funds, nursing students are awarded loans that

can become scholarships if they work in the state of Arkansas for one calendar year after graduation and licensure.


The Continuing Education fund is also a separate fund that allows the Board of Nursing to collect registration fees for the educational workshops provided by the Board of Nursing. The designated funds from the registration fees are used to offset the costs associated with providing this service.

The Criminal Background Check fund is a separate cash fund the Board uses to collect and submit payments for the state criminal background checks for applicants and employees. This fund was established to allow ASBN to run the state background checks online. Online processing shortens the time to receive the results and speeds the application process.

The ending balance in the operating fund as of June 30, 2008 was \$2,962,463.97. The balance in the NNB (Continuing Education Workshop) Fund was \$50,036.82. The balance in the MBP (Nursing Loan) Fund was \$47,730.14. The balance in the NNB (Criminal Background Check) Fund was \$5,707.74




INCOME GRAPH

RENEWALS

The *Nurse Practice Act* requires biennial license renewal for practicing nurses. Renewal reminders are mailed at least thirty days before the license expiration date. Nurses who allow their licenses to lapse and who have not practiced nursing during the preceding licensure period may be reinstated upon request, payment of the renewal fee and late penalty, and after meeting the continuing education requirements. Nurses who do not renew are in good standing as long as they do not practice nursing in Arkansas. Legislation to require continuing education prior to license renewal was passed in the 2001 Legislative session.

NURSING DISCIPLINE

The Arkansas *Nurse Practice Act* and its *Rules* provide that the Board may deny, suspend, revoke, limit or otherwise discipline any license to practice nursing or certificate of prescriptive authority for certain causes. These causes include: (1) is guilty of fraud or deceit in procuring or attempting to procure a license to practice nursing; (2) is guilty of a crime or gross immorality; (3) is unfit or incompetent by reason of negligence, habits, or other causes; (4) is habitually intemperate or is addicted to the use of habit-forming drugs; (5) is mentally incompetent; (6) is guilty of unprofessional conduct; (7) has had a license, certificate, or registration revoked, suspended or placed on probation or under disciplinary order in any jurisdiction; (8) has voluntarily surrendered a license, certification, or registration and has not been reinstated in any jurisdiction; or (9) has willfully or repeatedly violated any of the provisions of any chapter of the Arkansas *NPA*. The Arkansas *NPA* further

provides that the Board shall refuse to issue or shall revoke the license of any person who is found guilty of or pleads guilty or nolo contendere to any offense listed in §17-87-312(e).

Inquiries and reports to the Board concerning safety in individual nursing practice continue to increase. Investigations of these inquiries and reports are completed by Board staff, legal counsel or other governmental agencies. During its investigations, the staff has continued to emphasize the Board's commitment to the due process afforded each licensee under the provisions of the Arkansas *NPA* and the Administrative Procedures Act as well as the Board's charge to protect the public. During the reporting period, 813 complaints were closed, 349 cases were pending, and 849 cases were opened. At the end of the reporting period 36 cases were awaiting hearings and 51 cases were awaiting consent agreements.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION BY THE BOARD OF NURSING

One of the methods used by the Board of Nursing to insure protection of the public is to cause the prosecution of persons violating provisions of sections 17-87-101 through 17-87-402 of the Arkansas *Nurse Practice Act*. The following is the order of disciplinary proceedings against nurses in the state of Arkansas:

LETTER OF COMPLAINT RECEIVED

Reviewed by Board Staff	⇒	Request a formal investigation Gathers additional information Determines not additional information needed
General Counsel reviews complaints and investigative information	⇒	Determines charges of violation of <i>Nurse Practice Act</i> Determines whether disciplinary action should be pursued.

IF DISCIPLINARY ACTION IS PURSUED, THIS CAN BE ACCOMPLISHED IN ONE OF TWO WAYS:

CONSENT AGREEMENT

The Board staff determines the violations and proposed stipulations. Board Attorney draws up a legally binding agreement.



The licensee receives a copy of the Agreement, agrees to the terms, including waiving their right to a hearing before the Board, signs the agreement, and returns it to the Board office. (If the licensee refuses to sign the agreement, the Disciplinary Hearing process begins.)



Board attorney and a staff witness sign the Consent Agreement and forward it to the Board.



Board President signs the Consent Agreement following a majority approval by the Board.

DISCIPLINARY HEARING

The General Counsel files formal charges. This may be done initially or after the licensee refuses a Consent Agreement.



Disciplinary Hearing is Held

If the Board finds the nurse violated the Nurse Practice Act:



Disciplinary Order

The Board issues an Order setting forth the discipline. (reprimand, probation, suspension, revocation or limitation).

This Order becomes effective the day it is signed.




Appeal


The licensee may appeal this decision to the circuit court of the County in which he or she resides or the Circuit Court of Pulaski County, AR.

If the Board finds that the conduct which was charged did not occur or that the conduct which did occur is not a violation of the *Nurse Practice Act*, the case is Dismissed and no further action is taken.

NURSING PRACTICE

The profession of nursing is a dynamic discipline. Practice potentials change and develop in response to health care needs of society, technical advancements, and the expansion of scientific knowledge. All licensed nurses share a common base of responsibility and accountability defined as the practice of nursing. However, competency based practice of scopes of individual nurses may vary according to the type of basic licensure preparation, practice experiences, and professional development activities. The parameters of the practice scopes are defined by basic licensure preparation and advanced education. Within this scope of practice, all nurses should remain current and increase their expertise and skill in a variety of ways, e.g., practice experience, in-service education, and continuing education. Practice responsibility, accountability, and relative levels of independence are also expanded in this way.

The licensed nurse is responsible and accountable, both professionally and legally, for determining his/her personal scope of nursing practice. Since the role and responsibilities of nurses, and consequently the scope of nursing practice, is ever changing and increasing in complexity, it is important that the nurse make decisions regarding his/her own scope of practice.

The Board of Nursing answers specific questions from individuals or entities regarding scope of practice or standards of practice. To facilitate this process the Nursing Practice Committee investigates practice standards and submits recommendations to the Board for their approval.

LICENSURE

The *Nurse Practice Act* requires that any person practicing as a(n)

- Registered Nurse
- Advanced Practice Nurse
- Registered Nurse Practitioner
- Practical Nurse, or
- Psychiatric Technician Nurse

in this state shall be licensed by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing. Legislation enacted in 1979 authorized the licensing of registered nurse practitioners. Act 409 of 1995 created advanced practice nurse licensure. This licensure includes the previous categories of certified registered nurse anesthetist and certified nurse midwives and adds licensure of advanced nurse practitioners and clinical nurse specialists. Appendix B gives totals of nurses licensed in Arkansas by licensure category and county of residence. The information is derived from those questions that are completed on the licensure renewal forms. Incomplete data indicates that the licensee did not provide that information.

ADVANCED PRACTICE – PRESCRIPTIVE AUTHORITY

In February of 2008 Governor Mike Beebe appointed new members to the Prescriptive Authority Advisory Committee. The committee members include: Ms. Janice Deen, Ms. Lisa Martin, and Dr. Lori Ellis, all advanced practice nurses; Jerry Malott, M.D.; and Dr. Jeremy Veteto, pharmacist.

Act 409 of 1995 gave the Board authority to grant certificates of prescriptive authority to qualified advanced practice nurses. Advanced Practice licensure categories and numbers of licensees granted a certificate of prescriptive authority during the reporting period are identified below:

EXAMINATIONS

Licensure examinations for registered nurse and practical nurse candidates are administered via computerized adaptive testing. State boards of nursing contract with the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) for these examinations. In Arkansas, tests are administered by technology centers located in Little Rock, Fort Smith and Texarkana. A candidate may test at any center nationwide or internationally for licensure by the Board that provided authorization to test.

The licensure examinations have one purpose: to test knowledge, skills and abilities essential to the safe and effective practice of nursing at the entry level. The use of national RN and PN examinations facilitates licensure by endorsement from one jurisdiction to another. The passing standard is set by a panel of practicing nurses who are knowledgeable of entry-level nursing practice. Membership on the panel is open to all NCSBN jurisdictions. Examination results are reported to boards of nursing and to the candidates as either “pass” or “fail”. Unsuccessful candidates are provided with a performance report that gives information on areas for remedial study.

The Board participates in the test development system administered by the testing service of the NCSBN. The Arkansas Board approves practicing nurses to participate in RN and PN item writing, item review, and standard-setting panels.

Graduates of an approved nursing program are eligible for licensure in Arkansas after passing the National Council Licensure Exam (NCLEX®). The number of Registered Nurse and Licensed Practical Nurse licenses issued by exam is shown in the following table:

ENDORSEMENTS

Pursuant to the *Arkansas Nurse Practice Act*, the Board may issue a license to practice nursing by endorsement to an applicant who is duly licensed as a nurse under the laws of another state, territory or foreign country if the applicant meets Board qualifications. Applicants for endorsement must have successfully completed a nursing education program, the appropriate NCLEX®, and must be verified by the jurisdiction of original licensure. In addition to these requirements, advanced practice nurses shall have documentation of current unencumbered advanced practice license/authority to practice in another jurisdiction. Nurses licensed in Arkansas by interstate endorsement from each state during the reporting period (July 1, 2007 – June 30, 2008) are identified below:

MEDICATION ASSISTANTS-CERTIFIED

Act 1423 of 2005 gave the Board authority to grant certification to qualified unlicensed persons to administer certain medications in facilities determined by the board. The Board decided to allow medication assistants only in Arkansas nursing homes in which nursing supervision is available and nurse patient ratios are legislatively required. This authorization included persons who have met certain qualifications in Arkansas or who have met substantially similar qualifications and held similar credentials under the law in another state. In addition, in 2007, persons who have completed a certain portion of a nursing education program may be eligible to take the certification exam and work as a MA-C if successful. The table below lists the numbers of medication assistants granted certification in Arkansas during the reporting period.

VERIFICATIONS

The credentials of nurses holding original licensure in Arkansas are verified to other jurisdictions upon request of licensees. The National Council of State Boards of Nurses through the national nurse database referred to as Nursys® sends verifications directly to boards of nursing in other jurisdictions. Graduates of Arkansas nursing programs seeking to practice in other jurisdictions must meet the qualifications for licensure of that state or country.

NURSING EDUCATION

Continuing education for license renewal and reinstatement was mandated by Act 86 of the 2001 Arkansas legislative session. The regulations were put into effect beginning July 1, 2003. Random audits for compliance with the continuing education requirements are conducted each month. Four hundred fifteen (415) nurses (209 RNs, 206 LPN/LPTNs) were audited with a 96.8% compliance rate. Twenty-six Letters of Warning were issued for meeting the continuing education requirements after the nursing license was renewed. Six Letters of Reprimand were issued for failing to meet the continuing education requirements.

The Arkansas State Board of Nursing approves programs preparing registered nurse and practical nurse candidates for licensure. The *Nurse Practice Act* requires that the Board prescribe minimum standards, approve curricula and survey educational programs through its authorized representative. During the reporting period, two registered nurse and nine practical nurse programs were surveyed. Curriculum consultation and lectures by Board staff were provided to nursing education programs throughout the state.

Federal and Arkansas criminal background checks are required of all individuals applying for an initial license in Arkansas. During the 2007-2008 fiscal year, approximately 3,911 Arkansas criminal background checks and 3,904 federal criminal background checks were entered into the board's database. There were 621 investigations completed on applicants with a positive criminal background check.
